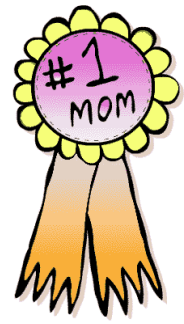




# Mrs. Sciacca's May Class News

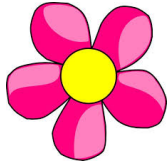
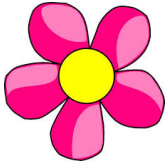
**\*\*Please have children use the bathroom before school begins - some students need to use the bathroom within the first 15 minutes of school\*\***

# What we are learning this month ...



During the month of May we will learn about ponds, bugs, caterpillars, life cycle of a butterfly!

Our discussions in Science will center on the life cycle of a butterfly. We will be observing the changes that a caterpillar makes as it changes into a butterfly. We will also be observing the seeds that we planted, watering them daily, watching them grow into plants. We will also learn about lady bugs, inchworms, and fireflies. In Social Studies, we will discuss Memorial Day.

Our activities will include theme related projects, Mother's Day, butterfly releasing, bugs and pond animals!



We will continue to work on mastery of our prayers; morning prayer, the snack prayer, Our Father and Hail Mary Prayers. We will continue our daily prayers and I hope that they share them with you at home.
