The themes for the month of November: Fall, Harvest, Leaves, Thanksgiving, and Veteran's Day

We are enjoying the Fall season. The leaves are changing color and the children like collecting them on the playground. We will conduct a leaf investigation this month. Next, we will introduce letters Ff, Gg, and Hh. Finally, we will begin preparing for the Thanksgiving holiday.

Math:

The lessons will include comparing sizes. The numbers three, four, and five will be introduced. Square and rectangle shapes will be presented. There will also be a daily review of numbers, shapes, and the identification of patterns.

Art Projects:

Some of our art projects will include: leaf rubbing, finger painting, creating fossils out of sand clay, and constructing a "Thankful Turkey". These activities will develop small muscle skills, eye/ hand coordination, and the development of skills for cutting and writing.

Religion:

We will help the children appreciate the Thanksgiving holiday as a day set aside to thank God for all his gifts to us. Also an introduction of the sign of the cross as a sign that shows they are loved by God.
