The first month of school is here! Your children will be "busy little beavers" getting acquainted with each other and the classroom rules and routines.

This month we will be working on an "apple theme." The children will create mosaic apples, apple trees and many more apple projects. They will find the magic surprise in every apple and they will also participate in an apple taste test! The students will learn to graph when they display their favorite choice of apple. We will be learning many new apple songs and poems.

The children will also be introduced to the topic of "manners." We will discuss manners in and out of the classroom, and read many books on this topic. The students will be sure to implement this new information in their daily routines.
